### **Who Should Take This Course?**

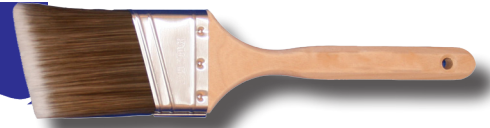
- ✓ Housing Rehabilitation Contractors/Supervisors

### **Why Should I Attend This Course?**

**It's the law!!** HUD requires the use of certified abatement contractors to perform federally funded rehabilitation work. If you are interested in bidding on future WCDA projects that will be funded with federal funds, this program certification is required. ### **There are Three Courses. Which one should I take?**

- If you are . . .** A General Contractor or the Supervisor of a General Contractor, you will need to take the four-day Lead Hazard Reduction Supervisor Course to work on federally funded projects.
- If you are . . .** A Worker for a general contractor, you will need to take the two-day Lead Hazard Reduction Worker Course to work on federally funded projects.
- If you are . . .** A Subcontractor, you will need to take the one-day Lead Safety for Remodeling, Repair & Painting Course. (As of 4/22/10, this certification is required for subcontractors providing renovations on all homes built prior to 1978.)



## How Much is this going to cost?

### 4-Day Supervisor Course:

- \$100 Registration Fee  
(must be submitted with registration)
- \$150 North Dakota State License Fee  
(due at the end of the course)
- \$550 EPA Certification Fee (good for 3 years)  
(due at the end of the course)

### 2-Day Worker Course:

- \$50 Registration Fee  
(must be submitted with registration)
- \$150 North Dakota State License Fee  
(due at the end of the course)
- \$280 EPA Certification Fee  
(due at the end of the course)

### Subcontractor Course: (Certification good for 5 years)

- \$100 Individual Registration Fee  
(must be submitted with registration)

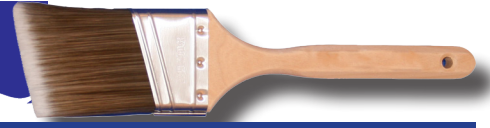
